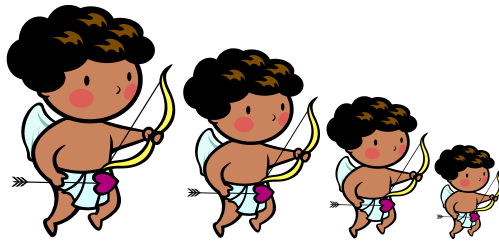


Newsletter
