Get ready to show your hand in the **Cards Afternoon** on the 17th at 2.30 - 4.00 p.m.

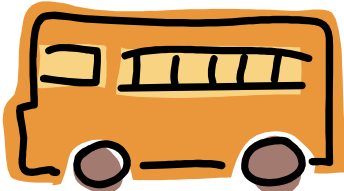


Don't miss **the Dog Racing afternoon** with snacks and beer on the 20th at 2.30 - 4.00p.m.
