Bring back those memories and join us on the 12th to take part in our Memory Lane quiz

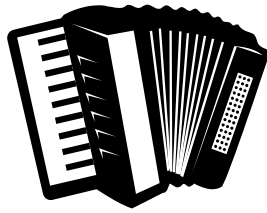


Take a pew for the Choir Sing-along on the 13th

18th Muscliff Family Fun Day at Muscliff Park - weather permitting will take as many residents as possible 11-4pm



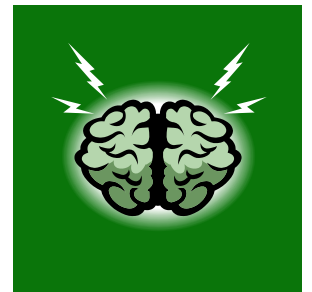
Choir practice & afternoon tea will be held for you all on 28th 2-4pm
